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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Felony 5th Degree Controlled Substance- Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000 fine

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/06/2018

Control #(ICR#): 18000508

Charge Description: On or about February 6, 2018, in Rice County, Minnesota, Heather Larscheid did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a Schedule II controlled substance, to wit: methamphetamine, having been previously convicted of violating chapter 152.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Pharmacy - Possess/Control/Manufacture/Sell/Furnish/Dispense/Dispose of Hypodermic Syringes/Needles**

Minnesota Statute: 151.40.1

Maximum Sentence: up to 90 days jail, or \$1,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/06/2018

Control #(ICR#): 18000508

Charge Description: On or about February 6, 2018, in the County of Rice, Minnesota, Heather Anne Larscheid-Anderson did unlawfully possess hypodermic needles.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:

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Complainant and/or Signing Officer designated below, declares under penalty of perjury, that he/she has reviewed police reports relating to the above-named Defendant and the allegations contained herein, and/or has spoken with peace officers having knowledge of the incident, and based upon that information, believes the following to be true and correct.

On or about February 6, 2018, an officer with the Faribault Police Department was patrolling the area of Highway 60 and Park Ave in the City of Faribault. The officer noticed a female, later identified as Heather Anne Anderson Larscheid, DOB: 10/17/1979 (hereinafter female defendant), and a male, identified as Zachery Lucas Bongers, DOB: 05/10/1992 (hereinafter the male defendant), getting into an argument outside of a vehicle.

The male defendant had an active warrant for his arrest out of Scott County. The officer then activated his lights and pulled up behind the parked vehicle. At this time, the female defendant was in the driver's seat, another male was in the passenger seat, and the male defendant was in the back seat of the vehicle. The officer made contact with the occupants. The officers asked if the male defendant was Zachary Bongers. The male defendant first replied no, but quickly stated that he was in fact Zachary Bongers. The male defendant was placed under arrest. During a search incident to arrest, the officer located two hypodermic needles in the male defendant's left sweatshirt pocket. The male defendant stated the needles were not his and that he just picked up the sweatshirt from his grandmother's house.

Having just found hypodermic needles on a recent passenger of the vehicle, and knowing the female defendant was arrested three days prior, in the City of Faribault, for possession of methamphetamine, the officer requested a K9 sniff on the vehicle. An officer responded with a K9 to conduct a sniff. The K9 alerted to different areas in the vehicle. The K9 alerted to the seat covers, and a backpack in the back seat that was on the seat covers. While searching the vehicle, the officer located a hypodermic needle loaded with a liquid in the front pocket of the backpack that the K9 alerted to. The liquid tested positive for methamphetamine. While searching the rest of the backpack, the officer noticed there was women's clothing inside the pack. The clothing appeared to be the correct size of the female defendant. The officer also noticed multiple hair ties, and hand written letter addressed to "Heather" inside the backpack.

The female defendant was then placed under arrest for possession of hypodermic needles and 5<sup>th</sup> degree controlled substance possession. The female defendant was holding onto her purse at the time of the arrest. While searching her purse, the officer located a second hypodermic needle inside the purse. That needle also contained a liquid that tested positive for methamphetamine. The officer also located a small glass vile with a clear liquid inside.

The female defendant was previously convicted of violating chapter 152 on May 9, 2017 in LeSueur County case 40-VB-17-253.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE:** Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 609.49., intentional failure to appear for duly scheduled court appearances may result in additional criminal charges, and in addition to any arrest warrant that may otherwise be issued by the Court.
