Todd Lippert announced today that he is a candidate for the District 20B seat in the Minnesota House of Representatives. District 20B covers the cities of Northfield, Lonsdale, Montgomery, part of New Prague, Dundas, seven Townships in Rice County and four townships in Le Sueur County. Lippert plans to seek the DFL endorsement on May 22.

Lippert was raised in a small Iowa farm town and has been serving as a pastor in the United Church of Christ for 15 years. His first parishes were in rural areas and small towns, including Dodgeville and Mineral Point WI. He is in his 6th year as Senior Minister at First UCC in Northfield.

Lippert stated, "I have had the privilege to minister to people from all walks of life, in all occupations, in military service, and on farms and in small business. I worked to earn their trust and respect."

Healthcare is just one issue he will champion. Lippert stated, "I have watched and assisted people who have struggled to care for loved ones, to keep their jobs, to keep their health insurance. When people have to delay care because they fear the high cost or can't pay, the system is broken. I want to be a voice for the people I've served and for so many more who need access to affordable healthcare and mental healthcare."

Lippert has also been an advocate for members of the immigrant community, and for fully funding our children's education. Investments in clean energy, and the jobs that come with them is also a top priority.
