The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNTI

Charge: 609.53.1 - Theft-Take/Drive Motor Vehicle-No Owner Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(17)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/16/2018

Charge Description: On or about September 16, 2018, in the County of Rice, Minnesota, Joshua James Wrobleski did take or drive a motor vehicle without the consent of the owner or an authorized agent of the owner, knowing or having reason to know that the owner or authorized agent did not give consent.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:	

Complainant and/or Signing Officer designated below, declares under penalty of perjury, that he/she has reviewed police reports relating to the above-named Defendant and the allegations contained herein, and/or has spoken with peace officers having knowledge of the incident, and based upon that information, believes the following to be true and correct.

On September 16, 2018, deputies of the Rice County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to 8010 Kendall Ave., Northfield, Rice County, to a report of a male was in the area potential threatening a female, under the influence of methamphetamine and with an active warrant. The caller identified the male as Joshua James Wrobleski (DOB: 01/12/1981), the ex-boyfriend of her neighbor's daughter. Deputies ran Wrobleski's information and found that he did indeed have an active warrant.

When deputies arrived at the address they were informed that Wrobleski had just driven south on Kendall Ave. Deputy Malecha began driving southbound when he observed a small gray truck, which matched the description of the suspect's vehicle. The caller also stated that they believed the vehicle Wrobleski was driving was stolen. Deputy Malecha ran the vehicle's information and it come back as stolen. Deputy Malecha began to pursue the vehicle, using his radar to obtain the vehicle's speed, 77 mph in 55 mph zone.

Deputy Malecha initiated a traffic stop. The vehicle slowed to a stop. Deputy Malecha got out of his vehicle to conduct a traffic stop and Wrobleski then drove away in his vehicle. Deputy Malecha got back in his vehicle and began pursuing Wrobleski's vehicle again with lights and sirens on.

Deputy Malecha pursued the vehicle for approximately 1.2 miles at speeds from 75 mph to 90 mph. At one point, Wrobleski attempted to take a curve in his vehicle. Wrobleski lost control of the vehicle, crashed into a retaining wall, bounced off, and hit a vehicle traveling the opposite direction. The driver, L.J.F., and the passenger, J.A.F., both sustained minor injuries.

Deputy Malecha then exited his vehicle and began yelling verbal commands at Wrobleski. Wrobleski then exited his vehicle and fled on foot. Wrobleski began running through the front yards on 4th St. E. before going into the back yard of one house. As deputies pursued on foot, Wrobleski finally stopped and turned with his hands up.

Wrobleski admitted to using methamphetamine earlier in the day and further stated that he felt the effects of the methamphetamine while he was driving during the chase. Wrobleski stated that he heard he had a warrant, which is why he fled. As Wrobleski was placed into custody, Deputy Malecha noticed Wrobleski was holding a small plastic baggie in his hand. Wrobleski admitted that the baggie contained methamphetamine. The contents of the baggie containing 0.3 grams later field-tested positive for methamphetamine.
