Press Release Assistance of Identification of Burglary Suspect December 14, 2018

The Northfield Police Department is seeking assistance in identifying a suspect involved in a recent burglary at Cake Walk.

On Thursday December 6th Northfield Officers responded to Cake Walk bakery in response to a burglary that had taken place at approximately 11:50 p.m. the previous night. - Evaluate how your business secures cash, sensitive data, and/or valuable property after hours.
- Educate all employees regarding the security expectations of your business and the above listed suggestions.
