Directions

Buntrock Commons is the student center at St. Olaf College, Northfield.

From Interstate 35: Exit at Highway 19 and travel east about 6 miles to St. Olaf. Take a left at the entrance and follow the drive to the north edge of campus to the large parking lot in front of Buntrock Commons.

From Highway 3: If coming from the south, proceed through Northfield and take a left at St. Olaf Avenue (just past the Amcon). Go about 1 mile to the campus, then follow the drive to the top of the hill. Buntrock Commons is on your left.
