The City of Northfield is in the process of final design for the 2020 Mill and Overlay Project. A project location map is attached to the back of this letter, which illustrates the streets being considered for the 2020 Mill and Overlay Project. As part of the public engagement process, the City of Northfield will be hosting a neighborhood meeting to discuss the final design of the construction project.
